Health and Safety: As usual the health and safety of all students and adults is of paramount importance and for this reason it is necessary to again mention these issues. Thank you to the vast majority of our families who are safety conscious and pay attention to the road rules.

The Fence: Fencing the school means greater student safety and opportunities to really develop the internal areas use without fear of vandalism.

Mornings: Gates open 7:45am. Students should arrive from 8:15 and go to the undercover area (not classrooms) for supervision (with parents).

Day: Oval gates and front gates remain open, all others will be closed.

Afternoon: All gates open from 2:30pm. All gates closed (except front gates) at 3:30pm. Front gates (and the office) closed at 4:00pm.

Parking: An ongoing issue that will only be resolved by the cooperation of parents and safe drop off and pick up practices. Parking in no parking areas, staff car parks and near the large bins is definitely not safe and will not be tolerated. Please pay attention to all parking signs, particularly the disabled parking bays and the Kiss and Drive areas. Rangers will again be issuing fines for illegal parking.

Dogs: Department of Education policy states that **no dogs (or other animals) are allowed on school premises**, including near buildings, lawns or ovals regardless of whether they are on a lead or not. Our oval is available for dog exercising before 7:30am and after 3:40pm every day and all day on the weekends. Please pick up after your pets – some people don't.
