Once a report has been downloaded to Connect it will be available to you until your child finishes year 12 or until they leave the public schooling system.

We would also like to make you aware that the Physical Education, Art and Music specialist areas are reporting using the Western Australian Curriculum. Your child's grade has been moderated against the judging standards in the specific learning areas. As there are some differences between the old and new curriculum your child's grade may be different to what they have received in the past. Please do not be alarmed by this, we encourage parents to not only focus on grades allocated but to acknowledge the importance of the effort grade and the teacher comments.
