All cash and forms must be returned to the front office by Friday 14 September. Prizes will be ordered on Friday 14 September for delivery week 1 of Term 4.

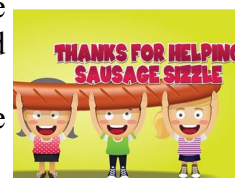
P&C Father’s Day Stall and Raffle
