Contributions and Charges

The Government provides a comprehensive education that satisfies the curriculum requirements of all students throughout Western Australia. Government funding is provided to schools for the operating costs associated with education. This funding covers costs such as the salaries for teaching, support staff and administrative staff, school buildings and facilities and certain materials. School communities are also encouraged to supplement the funds available to them through local fundraising. Each school determines how the relevant costs are distributed between contributions and charges pursuant to the requirements of the: School Education Act 1999 and School Education Regulations 2000.

Contributions

Education Department policy allows the school to request a contribution to assist with the cost of providing an educational program that meets the curriculum requirements. These funds go directly back into our school and are used towards providing materials used or consumed by students, including additional textbooks or the provision of classroom materials.

P & C Family Contributions

The Excelsior Primary School P&C Association voluntary approved request will be \$30.00 per family. The P&C contributions and money raised through fundraising are used to benefit the whole school community.

Extra cost options

Where possible the school covers associated costs of educating students but in some cases, we look to parents to support the payment of additional expenses. Some activities would not be possible without payment from all parents. Excursions (including camps) incursions and school social activities are examples. Students opt to take part in these activities or to use the services or facilities.

Personal items

Parents are responsible for the provision of a student's personal items. The list is detailed and provided to parents with the voluntary contributions and charges list. These can be purchased through Campion or from any other supplier. Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day so it will be necessary to replace some items, such as pens and pencils throughout the year. Please ensure all personal items are labelled clearly with your child's name.
